Thank you for being a part of our journey. Together, we are making a difference, one child at a time.





SUPPORTING OBJECTIVES (SO)

Preliminary Objective:

To identify brilliant kids from economically backward sections of the society and help them to continue their education.

Supporting Objectives:

Basis the 3 categories of students, we have 3 different objectives set for each such categories.

Category 1

Students who have taken admission in the schools and also are regular in going to the schools.

Category 2

Students who have taken admission but highly irregular/dropout kids, at going to schools.

Category 3

Students who have not enrolled for any kind of formal education.

Supporting Objectives (SO) – Category wise:

Basis the 3 categories of students, we have 3 different objectives set for each such categories.

SO of Category 1

- Sharpen the skills in academics and ensure the continuation of studies for brilliant students
- Sharpening the skills of teachers for better handling of kids of various ages and categories (adequate trainings to be provided)

SO of Category 2

- Ensuring that such students are regular at schools
- Also, helping them to sharpen their academic skills and identify brilliant students, along with helping them to complete education

SO of Category 3

- Ensuring that such students get immediate admission and enrolled into formal education
- Ensuring that such students go to schools regularly
- Also, all these students are ensured of continued education and identifying brilliant students for their continuous studies

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EDUCATION

Approach for SO of Category 1

- Identifying smart kids who are regularly going to schools
- Identifying their talents
- Ensuring of nurturing such kids
- Keeping their parents updated, for adequate support from their home
- Providing them financial support for their education, when required

Approach for SO of Category 2

- Identifying such Irregular or dropout kids
- Counselling with the parents of kids on such situation
- Attempting support such students' education financially (if required)
- Once they are back to school monitoring their attendance
- Also supporting them to sharpen their studies

Approach for SO of Category 3

- Identifying and reaching out to the kids and their families
- Understanding the challenges of such families
- Counselling the parents
- Approaching nearby government schools for admission of such kids into the schools
- Attempt to include private school managements also to help such deprived kids with education
- Arranging for campaigning to create awareness of education among the families of kids deprived with formal education





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THE IMPACT OF AQM SUPPORT SCHOOLS ON STUDENTS IN SLUM AREAS

"As per the last census data from 2011, the literacy rate in Mumbai was around 92.92% for males and 86.37% for females. The literacy rates were higher across genders in Mumbai's suburban areas. Literacy rates in Mumbai and its suburban areas were higher than the average of Maharashtra at 89.91%."

Based on the benchmark data, we conducted a survey at our supported schools, categorizing non-enrolled and dropout students into three groups by age.


4-6yr age	7-10yr age	11-14yr age	
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Basic education exams were administered across all AQM Foundation supported schools, segmented by age groups.


Basic education exams Syllabus consisted:

- children aged 4-6 know alphabets, numbers, and develop creative thinking;
- children aged 7-10 can read, perform simple math, and gain language proficiency; and
- children aged 11-15 can read fluently, solve complex arithmetic, think logically, and have general knowledge.

The graph below illustrates the literacy rates of AQMF supported school students compared to the Maharashtra state average of 89.91%.

This year, our primary focus was on developing online data accumulation systems, crafting curriculum content for education delivery, and innovating new methods to engage our diverse target audience, including children, youth, caregivers, and teachers.

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WHATME. THE

LEARNING CURRICULUM

Our learning curriculum for kindergarten to 1st standard children is meticulously crafted to foster a love for education and holistic development. In addition to our core curriculum essentials such as Narrative Ideas, Mindfulness, Constructivist Learning, and Diversity & Inclusion, we have integrated specific objectives into both content and pedagogy within a classroom setting.

New Objectives Integrated

- We provide classroom workshops and creativelearning opportunities tailored to students needs
- Our main emphasis is on fostering emotional resilience and navigating crises effectively
- We maintain a safe and confidential approach to protect student privacy
- Content is disseminated through appropriate channels to ensure effective distribution
- Our goal is to make learning accessible and free for all economically-backward students



WHAT WE DID

FACILITATE •

We reached out to schools and families to learn how they preferred to engage in social- emotional learning and support their children's education. At the same time, we refined and organized our curriculum from kindergarten level. We designed this curriculum using both synchronous and asynchronous methods to accommodate various learning styles and schedules.



SOCIAL

HOW THE PEOPLE OF BUDDHVIHAR COMMUNITY HALL STEPPED UP FOR CHILDREN'S EDUCATION

The representative from the Buddhvihar Community Center in Thane has consistently emphasized the importance of community involvement in education. They believe that by working together as a community, students and all those involved can access greater learning opportunities. Throughout this project, the strength of the community became evident as caregivers, neighbors, and volunteers joined forces to ensure the well-being of the children while also prioritizing their education.

DIGI-GYAN INITIATIVES

Parents and the broader community, including neighbors, friends, volunteers, and other acquaintances, took several measures to ensure that all children had access to smartphones, internet connections, and could safely progress in their school sessions/homework.

- Community Mapping conducted by our team ensured children had access to necessary technology for online learning
- Volunteers generously shared their phones, allowing children to learn from online free education platforms
- Neighbors offered their internet connection and phones to students, inviting them to join sessions from their homes
- Parents and older siblings refrained from taking their cell phones to work, ensuring children could complete their school/college homework/assignments, without interruption
- Parents underwent digital training to stay updated with their children's learning, and they actively participated by sharing pictures of students' work on class WhatsApp groups to showcase their progress



WHAT WE DID

CAPACITATE •

To ensure AQM Foundation initiatives reached a diverse range of individuals, we established partnerships with nonprofit organizations and teachers to extend our reach to students. The Programs Team underwent both in-house and external training sessions to enhance their competencies and provide optimal support to our students in the current environment. A diverse array of workshops, webinars, and trainings were organized to equip the team for workshops, community engagement, and serving our students and communities in the most effective manner possible.



TRAINING FOR EDUCATORS

We collaborated with nonprofit organizations and teachers citywide to expand our outreach to students. Through these workshops, we developed and delivered programs aimed at fostering self-awareness, nurturing healthy relationships, and enabling effective problem-solving among facilitators and adults. Our training sessions and workshops not only enhance the skills of educators but also broaden the network of individuals dedicated to using AQMF as a medium for student self-development.

- We tailored specific programs for students, age-wise, addressing their individual learning requirements
- AQMF sponsored learning initiatives and partner-specific training programs significantly contribute to our comprehensive training efforts

The AQM Foundation team partnered with the We Can We Will Foundation

NGO dealing in Education & Food for less fortunate, to conduct a six- week professional development program for school teachers aimed at enhancing their capacity to integrate Social Emotional Learning opportunities into their classrooms.

The training covered topics including cognitive teaching techniques, basic computer skills, and strategies for contextualizing teaching to better suit the students' needs and environment.



SOCIAL

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR TEACHERS AND AQMF PROGRAMMES STAFF

- Collaborated with We Can We Will Foundation NGO dealing in Education & Food for less fortunate, to deepen support for school teachers' understanding of highlighting students' strengths and fostering their learning
- Partnered with experts to further explore the role of art in facilitating social-emotional learning within AQMF support schools
- Engaged in dialogue sessions to collectively process any grief experienced by the team, generating strategies to support students facing similar challenges



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WHAT WE DID

ADVOCATE

To cultivate a supportive ecosystem for care and well-being, the AQM Foundation actively shares resources and collaborates with diverse organizations, conferences, and advocacy platforms. Through these partnerships, we aim to raise awareness and momentum for the student mental well-being movement.

#DIGI-SAKHI AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

The #Digi-Sakhi campaign focused on integrating digital awareness discussions into our everyday lives. We extended invitations to residents of Ambujnagar, Malad Slum area, encouraging open conversations about digital illiteracy.

Participants were invited to share personal challenges, experiences of distress, and similar concerns regarding their children's use of smartphones/laptops, along with their responses and available support.

Over 70 individuals actively participated in spreading awareness and educating themselves about digital literacy, becoming the voices of the campaign by sharing their impactful stories and experiences.

More Advocacy •

Continuous caregiver engagement is vital within AQMF.

Throughout the year, we prioritized involving caregivers of children in AQMF programs through various impactful conversations and dialogues. These sessions aimed to facilitate discussions on literacy growth, mental health, and mindfulness, especially during times of children's distress. The workshops were designed to acquaint parents with available support systems, well-being techniques, and simple self-care practices, particularly in situations where many are facing job loss and increased financial and caregiving responsibilities.



Education •

In FY23-24, AQM Foundation has supported students from economically backward area and provided education from primary to 10th Standard, while supporting 3 projects across 3 sites (Kandivali, Malad & Thane) of Mumbai.
