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






HOW WE USE OUR GRANTS

Our grants are used for both the financial and non financial needs of the organisations initiatives we support. Apart from adding capacity and scale, grants are used to build operational capabilities in areas such as



Basis the 3 categories of students, we have 3 different objectives set for each such categories.

CATEGORY 1

Students who have taken admission in the schools and also are regular in going to the schools

CATEGORY 2

Students who have taken admission but highly irregular/Dropout kids, at going to schools.

CATEGORY 3

Students who have not enrolled for any kind of formal education

Sharpen the skills in academics and ensure the continuation of studies for brilliant students.

Sharpening the skills of teachers for better handling of kids of various ages and categories (adequate trainings to be provided).



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APPROACH FOR SO OF CATEGORY 1

- Identifying smart kids who are regularly going to schools.
- Identifying their talents.

APPROACH FOR SO OF CATEGORY 2

- Identifying such Irregular or dropout kids.
- Counselling with the parents of kids on such situation.
- Attempting support such students' education financially (if required).
- Once they are back to school monitoring their attendance.
- Also supporting them to sharpen their studies

APPROACH FOR SO OF CATEGORY 3

- Identifying and reaching out to the kids and their families.
- Understanding the challenges of such families.
- Counselling the parents
- Approaching nearby government schools for admission of such kids into the schools.
- Attempt to include private school managements also to help such deprived kids with education
- Arranging for campaigning to create awareness of education among the families of kids deprived with formal education.



OUR INFLUENCE THROUGH THE YEARS

In FY22-23, AQM Foundation has supported students from economically backward area and provided education from primary to 10th Standard, while supporting 3 projects across 2 sites (Kandivali & Malad) of Mumbai. Over the year, through our supporters, we have been able to influence measurable change:



• Reached out to **250+** children through our learning enhancement programmes.

Supported 2 schools through the **Quality Education Programme**

• Worked closely with, and supported over **150+** parents who have limited resource for their child to deliver quality education.

WOMEN **EMPOWERMENT**

In FY22-23, AQM Foundation has supported 4 sessions with 2 NGO partners across 2 sites in Mumbai. Over the years, through our NGO partners, we have been able to make a significant impact:

- Supported 25+ women and girls by addressing their career-related issues and guiding their pathway
- Empowered 6+ women and girls by recruiting them as supporters in our support schools.

COMMUNITY RESILIENCE AND CLIMATE ACTION

In FY22, AQM Foundation has supported 3 projects, working for the most vulnerable communities across 2 sites in Mumbai. Over the years, through our supporters, we have been able to create significant impact, in a few critical areas:

- Conducted 2 Basic health and Eye Check-up camp at Malad and Kandivali Slum area for economically backward community.
- Initiated **2 beach clean-up** activities, clearing 200 kg plus garbage and plastic from beach
- Planted over **100** + trees, over the past 1 year in Mumbai Forest area.


STRENGTHENING CAPACITIES AND EMPOWERING COMMUNITIES





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CASE STUDY

The festival is aimed at demonstrating the immense possibilities that students holds within themselves to create a holistic learning phase. The festival was implemented in 2 support schools where the meaning and continuity of learning were just settling in for students. The 3 days training program titled "Samartha सामर्थ्य - Utsav" is a unique experience for the teachers (anchors) of the festival to prepare & implement on-ground with children. It brings forward the experiential learning format that is based on the belief that learning through experience builds effective facilitation skills. Over 50 students were trained in 5 learning studios: Poetry, Story Telling Art, Imagination, Drama and Music.



Samartha सामर्थ्य -Utsav Life Skills Assessment Tool was used to assess the children during the Learning Festival. The tool assesses children's life skills on:

- Self-Awareness and Regulation: ability to be mindful, resilient
- Self in Community: considering oneself as part of the community
- Self-Expression: ability to learn, curiosity and find means to communicate oneself



CASE STUDY

The data provided below reflects a sample population of 50 students who were observed on Day 1 as baseline and Day 3 as the endline data.

- ✓ 58 % of the students demonstrated a positive jump in Self in Community metric. This means that students were able to seek help and collaborate with others while working on their outputs be it sticking something together, working on story scripts etc. Students were also able to offer help on their own whenever they observed their classmates needed some kind of support in studio activities.
- ✓ 52% demonstrated at least one level of positive jump in the Self-Expression metric. More than half of the students were observed to be able to share what they had created during the festival. Children also shared their learning on the last day in front of their parents.
- ✓ 56% demonstrated resilience on the Self-Awareness and Regulation metric. Children were able to bounce back from the challenges they faced. One of the student group scouted for natural color material available near their school to prepare color shades, which helped them with painting, artwork, etc. On the last day of the festival, the children and (Teacher) facilitators invited the local community members - parents and local government leaders - to come inside the school premises where children's work had been displayed. Each group came forward in front of the community and presented their creation (play, music, performance etc.), and their learnings.

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AQM FOUNDATION'S EMPLOYEE **ENGAGEMENT MODEL**

AQM Foundation's employee volunteering programme ranges from short-term, to well-structured systematic plans that employees can be a part of, to assist non-profit organisations in overcoming issues of finite resources and sustainability. As per the programme, volunteers are provided with an opportunity to contribute towards institution strengthening, strategy formulation, as well as providing technological assistance to the NGOs.

FIELD VISITS IMMERSION PROGRAM

Employees visit support centres and interact with its target group. At times, they engage in a cleanliness drive, classroom teaching or participate in a donation drive.

CAPACITY BUILDING

Volunteers work over a period of time to meet requirements identified for several initiatives. This can include support on HR training and operational guidance, marketing collaterals, IT support, accounting and financial advisory.

DIRECT MENTORING

WELLNESS DAYS


With the idea to institutionalise wellness within community and kickstart the first wellness activity for the year, on 25th March 2023, was dedicated as 'Wellness Day, when group of doctors and medical practitioners has conducted basic health and eye check-up camp at Kandivali support school. Over 250+ people among slum community has consulted doctors.

LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT



HIGHLIGHTS

This year, we invited two facilitators, who presented modules on the following topics:

A) COLLEGE STUDENTS

The session was facilitated by 8 students of third year B. Ed from Guru Nanak Khalsa College, Matunga, Mumbai on alternate saturday of month March 2023. The team was provided with perspectives on how to manage time efficiently in a high-stakes environment with an overlap of tasks. An important takeaway from the session was how the optimum utilization of time would lead the way to smoother prioritization.





B) PEER LEARNING AND COLLABORATION

The session, conducted on 22nd March 2023 hosted by Dr. Vaishali Parmar (Assistant Manager – Employee Engagement, AQM Technologies Pvt Ltd), the team was asked to actively think about how sustainable initiatives had shaped their lives. In a series of self-reflective activities, Vaishali asked the team to write messages to themselves by placing themselves in different contexts. These activities got the team to open up to each other and share experiences and feelings that went beyond the professional set-up. A significant shared moment for the team was that despite coming from different contexts, similar things drive, motivate and impact us.



HIGHLIGHTS

C) FIELD TRIP AT NEHRU SCIENCE CENTER.

20 students along with teachers from both support school center at Kandivali and Malad visited Nehru Science center, Mumbai on 17th February 2023. Trip was facilitated to create a deeper connection with science and innovation idea and an opportunity to unwind their curiosity about science- bringing their unique selves to the front.
